Special techniques used on postage stamps, making them unique on a global scale

SALTED POSTAGE STAMPS 2013

In collaboration with Philatelic society Piran and the Piran Aquarium, the first and only salt stamps in the world were created.

Using thermography, Piran salt with a precisely determined moisture content was applied to postage stamps featuring motifs of our sea creatures in the form of animals.



LOUIS BRAILLE 2009

Postal Stamp with embossed print denominations in Braille - colored dots



SLOVENIAN BREAKFAST 2015

Postage stamp with the scent of honey

DOLPHINS AND WHALES 2016

The stamps feature additional UV printing, where black light (365–400 nm) reveals a motif that is otherwise invisible to the naked eye.
